# Secretary-Manager Report 2026

As I write this report, we are being teased by the idea of spring in Prince Edward Island. One day it is double-digit temps and sunny, the next it dives back down under freezing and snows. March/April is always a season of uncertain weather in these parts, but after what seems like a long winter, we're ready for some climbing temperatures and some consistency in the forecast.

Likewise, I think we'd all love to see some more consistency and predictability in the industry, in the economy, and in the world. Adjusting to what seems to be constant change and volatility is creating stressful conditions for many of us...I know it is for me. It is hard to make plans amid so much change and volatility, but plans need to be made regardless.

The Canadian dairy industry is by no means isolated from this pervasive wave of change and volatility; however, the predictability of our supply managed milk marketing system is saving us from the collapsing price of milk being seen in other countries. The high price of beef continues to provide higher value for bull calves and cull cows, especially for Milking Shorthorn breeders. At the same time, the growing usage of beef semen on dairy animals and the low availability of sexed Milking Shorthorn semen is cutting into replacement and registration numbers, and I am having a hard time finding available heifers for interested buyers. The Board is committed to continue finding new sexed semen options, and Milking Shorthorn breeders should consider trying to breed a few more heifers to fill some of the interest that exists.

Recent changes in milk marketing to incentivize protein production and lower SNF:Fat ratios should also be advantageous to our breed, as breed averages for fat and protein put the breed very much in the sweet spot for that ratio. As we see increasing butterfat percentages, we need

to keep putting emphasis on protein in our sire selection as well.

The efficiency of the Milking Shorthorn breed should also stand the breed in good stead in a world of increasing fuel and fertilizer prices. The reproductive efficiency, longevity, and feed efficiency of our breed is a winning formula in an inflationary economy. At the same time, we are seeing more Shorthorns excelling for milk production. Every year we set a record for the number of cows producing 10,000 kgs milk in 305 days, often after settling in calf on the first service and with low somatic cell scores. A key to profitability is managing expenses, which is where Milking Shorthorns shine.

The Board and I are continuing to try and find ways to bring efficient services to Milking Shorthorn breeders while finding new and innovative ways to promote the breed. A return of the National Online Sale last year was well received, and we have plans for it to return this fall. We are continuing to enhance and promote our embryo and heifer purchase programs for new breeders, and we will also be continuing to invest in herd visits to assist new and long-time breeders with access to information and completion of registry services.

There are a few things that all Milking Shorthorn breeders can do to contribute to the success of the Society and the breed. Firstly, please keep up to date with your registrations and transfers. This is not only a plus financially for the Society but increases the value of your animals. In addition, please feel free to send photos and videos to me of your Milking Shorthorns, either in the barn, in the pasture, or at the local 4-H show. We continually need fresh content for the website and social media to promote the breed. If you are on Facebook and don't follow the CMSS page and the CMSS Facebook Group, please do so! We are also present on Instagram...tag us with your posts!

I wish all Canadian Milking Shorthorn breeders the best in 2026. Please feel free to call, text or email me with your questions and comments. If you are encountering any issues with registry services, please contact me and I would be glad to assist in sorting out any problems you are having.

# New Canadian Sale Record



On May 15, 2025, Kolson Gianni Lady in Red set a new record for selling price for a Canadian bred and owned Milking Shorthorn at public auction when she sold for \$19,200 at the Mount Elgin Spring Spectacular Sale.

Kolson was consigned by Stephen & Janet Edwards and family of Cobden, Ontario. She is backed by five generations of VG and EX cows, including four EX cows. She sold to Benter Farms in Indiana, and proceeded to win classes at multiple shows in the USA last summer and fall.

Also selling at the same sale was Kolson Laser Lola, a calf who sold for \$4100 to Peter Vail of Florida. Very encouraging results for Canadian Milking Shorthorn genetics. Thanks to the Edwards for consigning such impressive individuals, and thanks to Mount Elgin Dairy Farms for including Milking Shorthorns in their sale.

In December, another Milking Shorthorn female, Cold Springs PV M Believe in Me ET, sold for \$19,500 in the Fall at the Falls Sale in Niagara Falls. This spring calf is American-born but was owned by Mount Elgin Dairy Farms, placing first in the Spring Calf class at the World Dairy Expo in October. This calf breaks the record for price for a Milking Shorthorn in Canada, selling to the Moretz Family of Nebraska.

## Updates to All Time Production Champions

**Oceanbrae Granite Leeann-P** sets a new record for 305 day milk and protein production by a Four Year Old. This VG-85-2yr daughter of Oceanbrae OPT Granite-P produced 14,062 kgs of milk, 459 kgs of fat and 454 of protein in her most recent lactation. Leeann-P is bred and owned by Oceanbrae Farms of Belmont, Prince Edward Island.

In the Ten Years and Older age group, **Oceanbrae Ironman Julie EX-90-2E** now holds the 2nd highest 305 day protein kgs, as well as the 3rd highest 305 day milk and fat kgs. At 11 years and 6 months, Julie produced 10,976 kgs of milk, 443 kgs of fat and 383 kgs of protein. This daughter of Oceanbrae Ironman-P from the “Bessie Joe” cow family was bred and owned by Oceanbrae Farms of Belmont, Prince Edward Island.

Farming is never without difficulty and 2025 is certainly no exception. Plus the year ended with a global price crash, which may not plateau until the third quarter of 2026. Against the backdrop of this uncertainty, cattle values have significantly increased and calf trade remains exceptional.

Registrations for Shorthorns have remained strong and new members continue to show interest, which leaves the breed in good shape. The Shorthorn consistently remains resilient in spite of upheaval within the sector. All those who promote the breed know that the Shorthorn is a medium sized, robust cow that consistently produces reliable yields. Built to withstand tough conditions. Built for longevity, to be efficient, to be low maintenance, to be healthy. Built to find profit within the margins, and that's why the breed continues to flourish.

The office remains in the very capable hands of Pedigree Livestock Services under Andy Ryder with Elizabeth Harrison running the day to day administration. As of February 2026, Graham Bell has stepped down from his position as Field Officer. His dedication and passion to the breed alongside his professionalism in the role will be sorely missed. Our current President, Sarah Slade, Brimclose Herd, is coming to the end of her term. Vice President Thomas Moscrop, Irthingelt Herd, will be stepping into the role at the next AGM in July. Council continues to push the breed forward. Genomics is forefront in this breed development. A hot topic for many years, this is now

a high priority as they set out to achieve a Dairy Shorthorn genomic base in the UK. Progress is positive, with a target of 2000 cows to be tested imminently.

Shorthorn Sires UK continues to be a vital and successful sister company under the expert guidance of Chairman Rob Kite. Daughters from the latest proven sire, Amber Firefox, are drawing favourable reviews across the UK. On the December proof run, he impressively came out as number 1 sire still available to use, number 6 overall and offers big improvements in milk. Coton-hall Solomon's initial proof also looks promising. He is sold out in the UK but we currently have a son, Burbrook Mega Mon, on centre for collection.

Other notable SSUK sires include Oxton Finnan, whose daughters are calving in now. They are also showing very promising conformation with one daughter classifying as a VG-87 2yr old. Amber Magnum daughters have been turning heads in the show ring, particularly at the All Breeds All Britain (ABAB) Calf Show. The SSUK directors continue to work to provide the best selection of Shorthorn genetics for our members and the worldwide Shorthorn community.

The highlight of the year has to be the show ring. Shorthorns have taken centre stage with success at Interbreed level, some in group classes and some for the main individual title. Coton-hall Bambam Cornelia took the supreme title at the Royal Welsh Show for the Thomas family, an electric moment for the family who have exhibited there for generations. Equally, Strickley Strawberry 21st won supreme at the Robinson family's local show, Westmorland.

The breed's National show moved to a new and exciting location, now held at UK Dairy Day, where the industry is really given a spectacular platform to shine. Congratulations to IRG Collins who won the Championship with Churchroyd Brontë Wildeyes 62. The Drisgol team were Reserve with Drisgol Belladonna 504 and newcomer Grant Pink was Honourable Mention with Rockstar Lady Barrington.

By far the most important show of the year is the ABAB Calf Show, a great event that encourages and supports the next generation. Here, our youngsters excel and this year certainly had a fantastic turn out of quality and quantity. The atmosphere ringside for the breed was definitely buzzing. Top honours went to SSUK bred Crossrigg Magnum Pauline from first time exhibitors the Harrison family.

As always, we welcome any visitors to the UK and wish everyone a positive and progressive year ahead.

# 2025 CMSS Field Day

It was a beautiful summer day in Prince Edward Island for the 2025 CMSS Field Day and AGM, hosted by the Barrett family of Oceanbrae Farms. This was the first time since 2013 that the Field Day has been held in PEI, and since this time, there has been a growth in the breed in the Maritimes. A number of these breeders from PEI, Nova Scotia and New Brunswick were joined by breeders from Quebec and Ontario for a tour of the Oceanbrae herd and our Annual General Meeting.

One highlight of the morning were a couple of judging classes. Dan Ulrick acted as official judge for the Two Year Old class, while James Knott acted as official judge for the “championship class” of cows who have all been featured in the CMSS Virtual Show.

Visitors were able to inspect the herd on pasture at the start of the morning, before moving the cows back into the sand-bedded free stall barn. This new barn was originally built in 2019 and rebuilt and reinforced in 2023 after damage from Hurricane Fiona. The Barretts milk approximately 75 cows with a double-8 DeLaval milking parlour. In summer, cows are pastured overnight and fed a TMR consisting of corn silage, high moisture corn, alfalfa silage and protein/mineral supplement during the day.

After lunch, Fred Barrett was honoured with the CMSS Distinguished Service Award (see page 18 for full report) for his contributions to the breed for more than fifty years. As well, Rob and Allison Ashton accepted the Master Breeder Award for Lynmark Farms. This was followed by a lively fun auction and then the Annual General Meeting. A special guest for the afternoon was Hon. Bloyce Thompson, PEI Minister of Agriculture and accomplished Holstein breeder who would serve as interim Premier for a couple of months in 2025 and 2026.

CMSS President Janet Edwards and Secretary-Manager Ryan Barrett reviewed the 2024 financial report and committee reports. The Society had a net income of \$5477 in 2024 and remains in a strong financial position. One of the biggest accomplishments of 2024 was the launch of genomic evaluations for our breed after considerable work by the Society to get animals tested, in partnership with a number of provincial and regional funding programs.

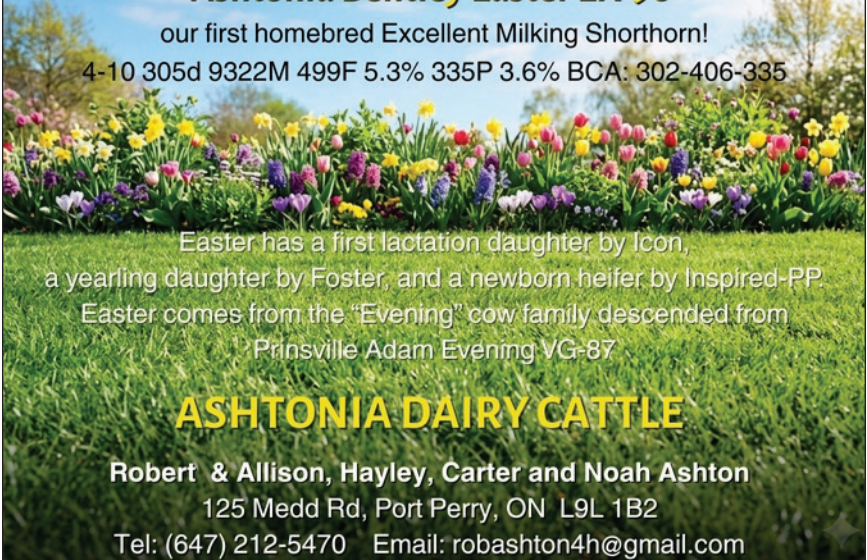

# Country Report: Australia

The Australian climate has thrown up all sorts of challenges for farmers over the past year. Floods, drought, heat waves and bush fires have impacted different parts of the country. One thing that definitely can't be said is that Australian dairy cows aren't bred to be resilient, because they have to be to thrive in our herds. Milk prices are generally quite strong currently, as are cull cow prices, and these factors have certainly helped weather the storm, so to speak. With many farms due to have milk price contracts renewed on July 1, most farmers are moving forward with some level of nervousness given that global dairy commodity prices have generally been trending downward.

The real positive for the Illawarra breed is the continued interest in Illawarra cattle, particularly from outside of the established herds. The Illawarra Cattle Society will be hopeful that this in time translates to increased memberships, registrations and semen sales, especially given that the Australian dairy herd continues to shrink.

One cow that has created real attention for the breed was the 2026 International Dairy Week (IDW) Grand Champion Llandoverly Treleven's Joan 2408 EX90. With two more generations of EX classifications behind her, she will definitely be a cow that will be targeted as a bull mother. Her sire Riversleigh Treleven (maternal brother to Tuck at Semex) was privately collected and therefore only used in a limited number of herds. He does however have a solid proof, including +35 kg Fat. The exciting thing for breeders is that a Treleven son Llandoverly Vinny is already available. Unfortunately for Canadian breeders he doesn't qualify for export.

A small amount of semen on Glenbrook Ghost has made its way to Canada recently. The bull himself is very correct, and would be expected to transmit below average stature with plenty of width and capacity. His dam Glenbrook Beauty Queen continues to add to her list of achievements, including Reserve Champion cow at the 2025 Adelaide Royal show, and then going on to win Champion of the South Australian On farm Challenge 11 months into lactation after having calved twins. Ghost's Maternal grandsire, Blackwood Park Liberton, continues to demand attention, with daughters winning both Reserve Senior Champion and Reserve Intermediate Champion at IDW 2026.

A full brother to Ghost's dam (Glenbrook Beauty's Reward) is also now in collection at Genetics Australia and does qualify for export to Canada. His dam Ovensdale Beauty 383 EX92 2E has now produced over 110,000 litres lifetime and still going. Most importantly she appears to be breeding very well, with the above mentioned Beauty Queen having a VG86 Treeton Pimp sister milking in the Riversleigh herd that has accumulated over 60,000 litres to date.

Another Liberton son Blackwood Park Latte - from an EX classified, former Number 1 index cow, is also available from Semex, but again unfortunately doesn't qualify for Canada.

Top Shelf Royal Laser has been used in Australia and is leaving some impressive heifers. The oldest being about 18 months old at the time of writing. Hopefully they make just as impressive udders and can provide the Illawarra breed with a much needed outcross of higher purity genetics.

# Subclinical Ketosis Evaluations

Starting December 2025, Brown Swiss, Canadienne, Guernsey, and Milking Shorthorn breeders will have access to genetic evaluations for Subclinical Ketosis. Lactanet has offered Metabolic Disease Resistance (MDR) evaluations since 2016 for Holstein, Ayrshire and Jersey breeds, covering Subclinical Ketosis, Clinical Ketosis and Displaced Abomasum traits. At that time, data for the other breeds was limited; however, years of accumulating milk BHB data has changed that.

Subclinical ketosis occurs when ketone levels rise in the bloodstream in early lactation due to a negative energy balance. It can lead to other metabolic diseases, impaired immunity, reduced milk yield, and poor reproductive performance. Unlike clinical ketosis, subclinical ketosis often goes undetected without monitoring programs such as Lactanet's KETOLAB service.

Genetic evaluations for Subclinical Ketosis rely on milk BHB (i.e.: milk beta-hydroxybutyrate) levels analyzed from every milk recording sample. This data has steadily accumulated, paving way for the future expansion of MDR evaluations for the smaller population dairy breeds. There are now around 7,000 first-lactation records and over 13,000 later lactation records for the Brown Swiss breed. For each of the Canadienne, Guernsey, and Milking Shorthorn breeds there are roughly 1,300 and 3,000 records for first lactation and later lactations, respectively. Data for clinical ketosis and displaced abomasum remains limited, so genetic evaluations for these traits are not yet possible for these breeds.

For Holstein, Jersey and Ayrshire, MDR combines evaluations for three traits with relative weights of 50% for Subclinical Ketosis, 25% for Clinical Ketosis, and 25% for Displaced Abomasum. For each of the smaller population dairy breeds, the Metabolic Disease Resistance index will be 100% Subclinical Ketosis with equal weight for first and later lactations. As with all functional traits, the index will be expressed as a Relative Breeding Value with an average of 100 and a standard deviation of 5. A higher RBV is associated with greater resistance to SCK. Reliability levels for official sires vary on average from 52% for the Guernsey breed to 65% for the Canadienne breed.

As with other breeds, the MDR index will be available on Lactanet-Gen.ca on an animal's Genetic Evaluation Summary page under the Functional section. Additional details can also be found on the Health page for males.

Metabolic diseases can significantly impact the profitability of dairy farms. Combining good management practices, during the transition period and early lactation, with genetic selection for MDR, now available for all breeds in Canada, is the best strategy to reduce disease risk and improve herd performance.

## Country Report: New Zealand

The New Zealand dairy industry has seen some solid prices during 2025, but as you well know solid prices can often been met with other challenges and for us, the weather continues to be unpredictable. Despite a weather pattern that sees part of our country be either too dry or too wet, milk production overall is steady.

The main dairy company continues to adapt and evolve its pay-out system. For a number of years, the company has had a variable portion of pay out linked to meeting certain requirements and this has added several cents to the total pay out if you meet these. The current season has seen the variables change with the addition of carbon emission now added to the other variables in the bottom tier.

Since writing last year's report, we have held the annual New Zealand Milking Shorthorn Association Conference in the Waikato (North Island) in April. This was a great few days where our breeders got behind the scenes to see what happens to our on-farm milk and DNA samples. All samples in New Zealand are sent to the Waikato for testing and the systems in place to manage this so farmers receive timely information and data is impressive. The 2026 annual conference was recently held in Palmerston North in March in conjunction with the International Red Breeds Conference and tour.

As noted in last year's report, the interest in our breed continues to

grow so while we have had some breeders no longer exhibiting at the New Zealand Dairy Event, we have more individual breeders doing so with maybe one or two head as well a some of our more established herds in attendance. On-farm competitions entries continue to also grow around the country.

Red Breed Genetics continues to look for bulls which have good type, have above average milk volume, high components, are A2A2, are polled and have good colour, just to name a few traits. A key trait that we're looking for in New Zealand is higher components. This sits alongside the need to widen the genetic base. The bulls New Zealand has in its latest selection can be found on the Semex New Zealand website.

Red Breed Genetics also is working to find a bull that would be of interest to overseas breeders and are therefore looking into the export market.

Other events that profile Milking Shorthorns are our on-farm competitions, school lamb and calf pet days, and the Central Districts Field Days.

During the AMSS Junior Show, Henkeseen Stargazer Razor (Kuszmar Mercury Stargazer ET), owned by Matthew Winch, was selected as Junior Champion, with Top Shelf Let's Get Busy ET (Gold Mine Royalty Dane EXP TW), owned by Tristan Upchurch, named Reserve Junior Champion.

The National Sale featured lively bidding on a high-quality lineup of animals. Topping the sale at \$5,600 was Cherrywood CS Lonna ET, a fresh Junior 3-Year-Old sired by Halpin's' Muddy Rockstar, purchased by Jim Marak.

A strong Milking Shorthorn lineup wrapped up the 2025 show season at the Winter National. Aaron Heinzmann named Heavenly Zora (North Stars Famous Patriot EXP) Grand Champion, with Mile High Light My Fire EXP (GE Lazy M Apples Legacy) selected as Reserve Grand Champion.

# Rapport du secrétaire 2026

Au moment où j'écris ce rapport, l'idée du printemps nous fait languir à l'Île-du-Prince-Édouard. Un jour, le mercure grimpe à deux chiffres et le soleil brille, le lendemain, le froid retombe et la neige s'abat. Mars et avril sont toujours synonymes de météo incertaine dans la région, mais après un hiver qui nous a paru interminable, nous sommes impatients de voir les températures remonter et les prévisions météorologiques se stabiliser.

De même, je crois que nous souhaiterions tous plus de stabilité et de prévisibilité dans l'industrie, dans l'économie et dans le monde. S'adapter à ce qui semble être un changement et une volatilité constants est source de stress pour beaucoup d'entre nous... c'est mon cas, en tout cas. Il est difficile de faire des projets dans un tel contexte de changement et de volatilité, mais il faut s'y atteler.

L'industrie laitière canadienne n'est pas à l'abri de cette vague de changements et de volatilité généralisée; toutefois, la prévisibilité de notre système de commercialisation du lait, fondé sur la gestion de l'offre, nous protège de l'effondrement des prix du lait observé dans d'autres pays. Le prix élevé du bœuf continue de valoriser les veaux mâles et les vaches de réforme, notamment pour les éleveurs de Shorthorn Laitier. Parallèlement, l'utilisation croissante de semence de bœuf pour les vaches laitières et la faible disponibilité de semence sexée de Short-horn Laitier réduisent les effectifs de remplacement et d'inscription, et il m'est difficile de trouver des génisses disponibles pour les acheteurs intéressés. Le Conseil s'engage à poursuivre la recherche de nouvelles options de semence sexée, et les éleveurs de Shorthorn Laitier devraient envisager d'inséminer davantage de génisses afin de répondre à la demande.

Les récentes modifications apportées à la commercialisation du lait pour encourager la production de protéines et réduire le ratio des solides non gras devraient également être avantageuses pour notre race, car les moyennes de la race en matière de matières grasses et de protéines la placent dans la fourchette optimale pour ce ratio. Face à l'augmentation des pourcentages de matière grasse, nous devons continuer à privilé-

gier les protéines dans la sélection des taureaux reproducteurs.

L'efficacité de la race devrait également lui être précieuse dans un contexte de hausse des prix des carburants et des engrais. L'efficacité reproductive, la longévité et l'efficacité alimentaire de notre race constituent un atout majeur dans un contexte économique inflationniste. Parallèlement, nous constatons une augmentation des performances laitières des Shorthorns. Chaque année, nous battons un record du nombre de vaches produisant 10 000 kg de lait en 305 jours, souvent après une gestation réussie dès la première insémination et avec un faible taux de cellules somatiques. La maîtrise des dépenses est essentielle à la rentabilité, et c'est là que les Shorthorns Laitiers excellent.

Le Conseil d'administration et moi-même continuons de rechercher des solutions pour offrir des services efficaces aux éleveurs de Shorthorns Laitiers, tout en explorant des moyens novateurs de promouvoir la race. Le retour de la Vente nationale en ligne l'an dernier a été très bien accueilli, et nous prévoyons de la reconduire cet automne. Nous poursuivons le développement et la promotion de nos programmes d'achat d'embryons et de génisses pour les nouveaux éleveurs, et nous continuerons également d'investir dans les visites d'élevages afin d'aider les éleveurs, nouveaux comme expérimentés, à accéder à l'information et à compléter les services d'enregistrement. Voici quelques gestes que tous les éleveurs de Shorthorn Laitier peuvent adopter pour contribuer au succès de la Société et de la race. Tout d'abord, veuillez tenir à jour vos enregistrements et transferts. Cela représente un avantage financier pour la Société et augmente la valeur de vos animaux. De plus, n'hésitez pas à m'envoyer des photos et des vidéos de vos Shorthorns, que ce soit à l'étable, au pâturage ou lors d'expositions locales. 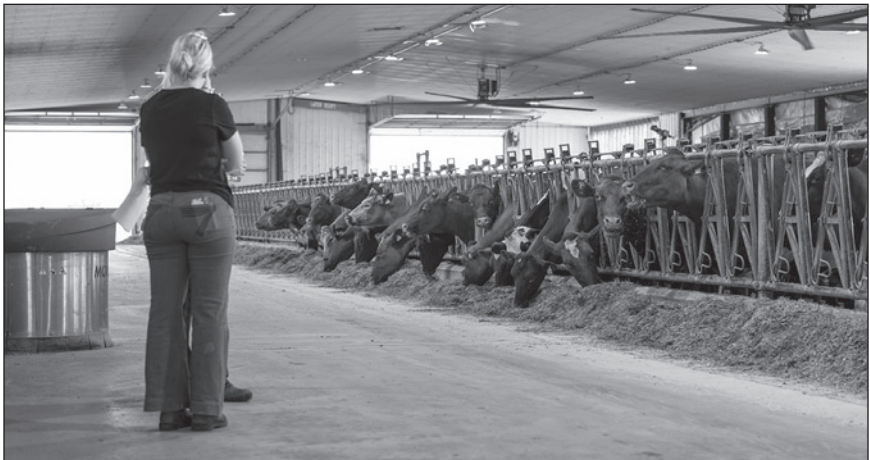

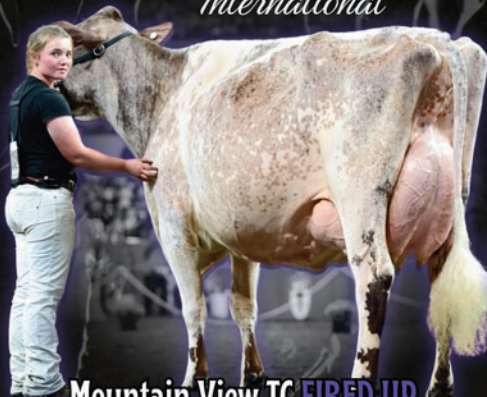

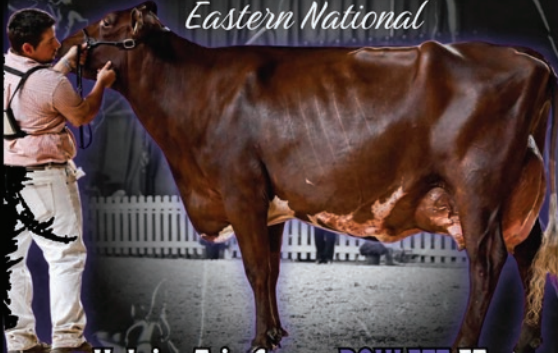
